1. Elementary Ceramics class in Ventura: two 8-week ceramics class that will not be completed until 2021 due to pandemic.
2. Awards to Ceramic Students: due to the COVID 19 pandemic our usual awards to Ceramics students at 2 high schools, 3 community colleges, and 1 university were only awarded at Ventura Community College and Santa Barbara City College.
3. Members' Meetings are advertised to the public and we average 3-7 visitors at each meeting. Due to pandemic only 3 public meetings have been held in 2020 but we are now holding meetings on Zoom.
4. Julie Feld Underglaze Workshop – offered, advertised and available to the public.
5. \$100 donation to Center for Nonprofit Leadership at California Lutheran University for free webinar workshop provided during the Covid 19 pandemic. May 2020
6. \$500 donation to Beatrice Wood Center for the Arts during the Covid 19 pandemic. May 2020
7. Jenchi Wu at VCC and Grey Duncan at Nordolf HS in Ojai were asking their students to photograph their work for their remote classrooms. We provided slides from Terry Wilson's January program on Photographing Your Work with each teacher. 5/4/2020

1. 144 students at local high schools, community colleges and the university received either an award for their work or clay classes/workshops
2. Ruthanne Turball Workshop
 - Ruthanne provided an afternoon demonstration to Ventura Community College Ceramic's students
 - Ruthanne provided an evening demonstration to Guild members and the public
 - Ruthanne provided two one-day workshops to members and the public
 - 5 students from Ventura Community College and CSUCI were provided with a 1-day workshop.
3. VCPG sale at Ojai – In order to give the Ceramics students from Ventura Community College an opportunity to experience selling their own work, they were invited to set-up, display, sell their work and provide demonstrations during our annual sale.
4. Eight Members' Meetings were advertised to the public, contained a program about Ceramics and we average 3-7 visitors at each meeting.
5. Bowl of Thanks: Once a year VCPG organizes an event at Ventura Harbor called the Bowl of Thanks. The Guild asks for donations of bowls from our members and the schools we work with and on the night of the event the public comes to the Ventura Gallery, purchases a bowl and then takes them to restaurants in the harbor that give them a sample of one of their offerings. 100% of the proceeds from this event go to a

local charity – one to care for humans and one to care for animals. In addition to the labor involved VCPG takes care of all advertising and credit card charges for the event.
